

## Open String Bugle Call

Classroom Guitar Tutor

Based upon Reveille

With Vigor  $\int = 120$ 





The "Open String Bugle Call" can be played on the guitar using three open strings -

String 4 - D (space below the staff)

String 3 - G (second line of the staff)

String 2 - B (third line of the staff)

Notice that there is a repeated note and rhythm pattern identified by a bracket. This pattern consists of the open strings played in the order of -

4 3 2 3 4 (the strings 2 and 3 are written closer together to indicate they are played with the faster rhythm of eighth notes)

An accompaniment of a "G" chord may be played using the following rhythms -

Whole - 1

Half -  $\frac{1}{1}$  2  $\frac{3}{2}$ Quarter -  $\frac{1}{1}$   $\frac{2}{2}$   $\frac{3}{2}$
